

Pentecost season is a liturgical period which immediately follows the Easter season. We sometimes refer to it as “ordinary time”. Although the start and end dates vary by liturgical tradition, the season typically begins on the day of Pentecost and continues throughout the rest of the liturgical year, ending just before the season of Advent. The liturgical color for this period is green at St. Stephen’s, symbolizing life, hope, and peace.
